RE: AWARD OF THE CONTRACT TO INSIGHT LLC

Amanda Amos, Procurement Coordinator, explained that the Authority had recently released a solicitation seeking proposals from qualified vendors to provide damage prevention and location services. The request for proposals was advertised on the County's website, in The Orange Review, and through eVA, Virginia's procurement website, and two (2) responses were received.

Ms. Amos indicated that staff recommended awarding a one-year contract to Insight LLC, with the possibility of four (4) additional renewals.

Discussion ensued among the Authority regarding: the location services necessary to comply with Miss Utility requests; the accuracy of the data in GIS; and the ability to scan and detect the fiber in the ground.

On the motion of Mr. Crozier, seconded by Mr. Frame, which carried by a vote of 4-0, with Mr. Goodwin being absent, the Authority awarded a contract to Insight LLC for damage prevention and location services for a period of one (1) year, with the possibility of four (4) additional renewals, as presented.
